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What is MTD for IT?

What is MTD for IT?

Self assessment as we know it is changing: what you need to know

2015 Making Tax Digital (MTD) was introduced

2022 MTD for VAT became mandatory for all VAT-registered businesses

2026 MTD for Income Tax (IT) for self-employed people and landlords is being implemented

→ What it means

Self-employed and landlords must use MTD-compatible software, such as Xero, to keep digital records and send updates to HMRC.

MTD for IT timeline

The key dates and deadlines for the MTD for IT roll out

April 2025	HMRC's public testing phase opens
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April 2026 Comes into effect for sole traders and landlords with qualifying income above £50,000

April 2027 Comes into effect for sole traders and landlords with qualifying income above £30,000

April 2028 Comes into effect for sole traders and landlords with qualifying income above £20,000

Benefits of MTD for IT

MTD for Income Tax brings benefits for your business

Some of the benefits of MTD for Income Tax are:

- ✓ A clearer view of your finances
- √ Help with decision-making and planning
- Automation of routine tasks so less time spent on manual processes





What you need to do

How the MTD for IT rules will affect you

MTD for IT will require self-employed people and landlords to:

- Submit <u>four quarterly updates</u>
- Submit a <u>final declaration</u> by 31 January
- Keep digital records
- Use MTD-compatible software



What landlords need to know

How the MTD for IT rules will affect landlords with jointly-owned property

Easements for landlords with joint-owned properties

Landlords of jointly-owned properties can choose:

- Not to submit quarterly updates of expenses
- To keep less detailed digital records


